




Update: 2019 Knights Party Congress and Family Retreat



The 2019 Knights Party Congress and Family Retreat was held during Labor Day weekend at Harrison, AR with special guest and keynote speaker William Johnson, chairman of the American Freedom Party and an international attorney based in Los Angeles (pictured above: left). Friday night kicked off with a chili supper and assorted desserts prepared by local supporters of the Christian Revival Center. Saturday, after attendees sat down to a breakfast of Southern style biscuits and gravy (youth corps member Caleb, (middle picture) smiles with Mrs. Robb and helps serve breakfast), the opening ceremony began at 9:30 with presentation of flags and pledge. Speakers on Saturday included Lisa from Texas, Joseph from California, Tom Bowie from Arkansas, attorney Jason Robb, evangelist Steve Kukla, and Eddie Miller, host at Blood River Radio. After a delicious dinner of roast turkey and the usual sides, the evening concluded with the solemn naturalization ceremony as new Knights were inducted and recognized for their effort.
